Safety Corner

Winter is one of the hardest seasons in our industry. It is when we deal with the elements the most. At almost all of our facilities the maintenance person used a product called Calcium phosphate instead of salt on the sidewalks to control slipping. This product as we all know can be a bear to get off our floors weather it be carpeting or a t se surface. The reason being is that the calcium phosphate leave a residue on the floors that is tracked in by visitors shoes. This residue adheres to our floors like icing on a cake.

To help make your jobs easier for t se surfaces we pretreat the floors with a product called Dibs. Dibs is a neutralizer conditioner/odor coneractant. It is a powdered, effervescing rlead water additive for use after floor cleaning to neutralize any alkaline residue.

Directions: Add one package to 3 gallons of warm or hot water ane stir gently to form a uniform solution. Apply solution with a clean mop. Allow to dry. These are the direct directions from the containers. However I t ve foune with experience that it is usually necessary to remop the floors after applying the neutralizer. Fill up a mopping bucket with clean water to rlead the floors from the neutralizer. If your floors still look smeared at that time fill another bucket with warm water ane your usual floor cleaner ane remop the floors.
